

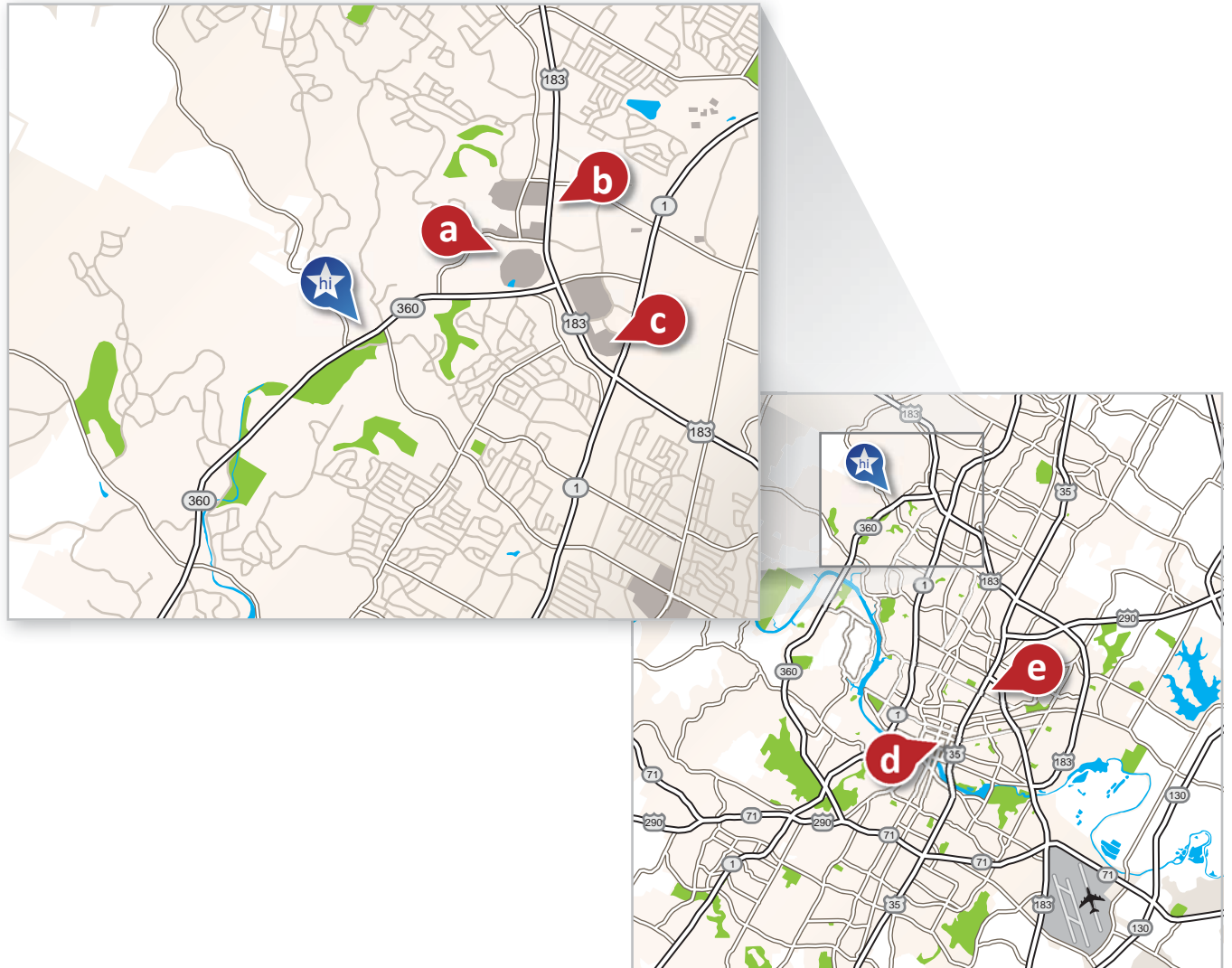

Hotels

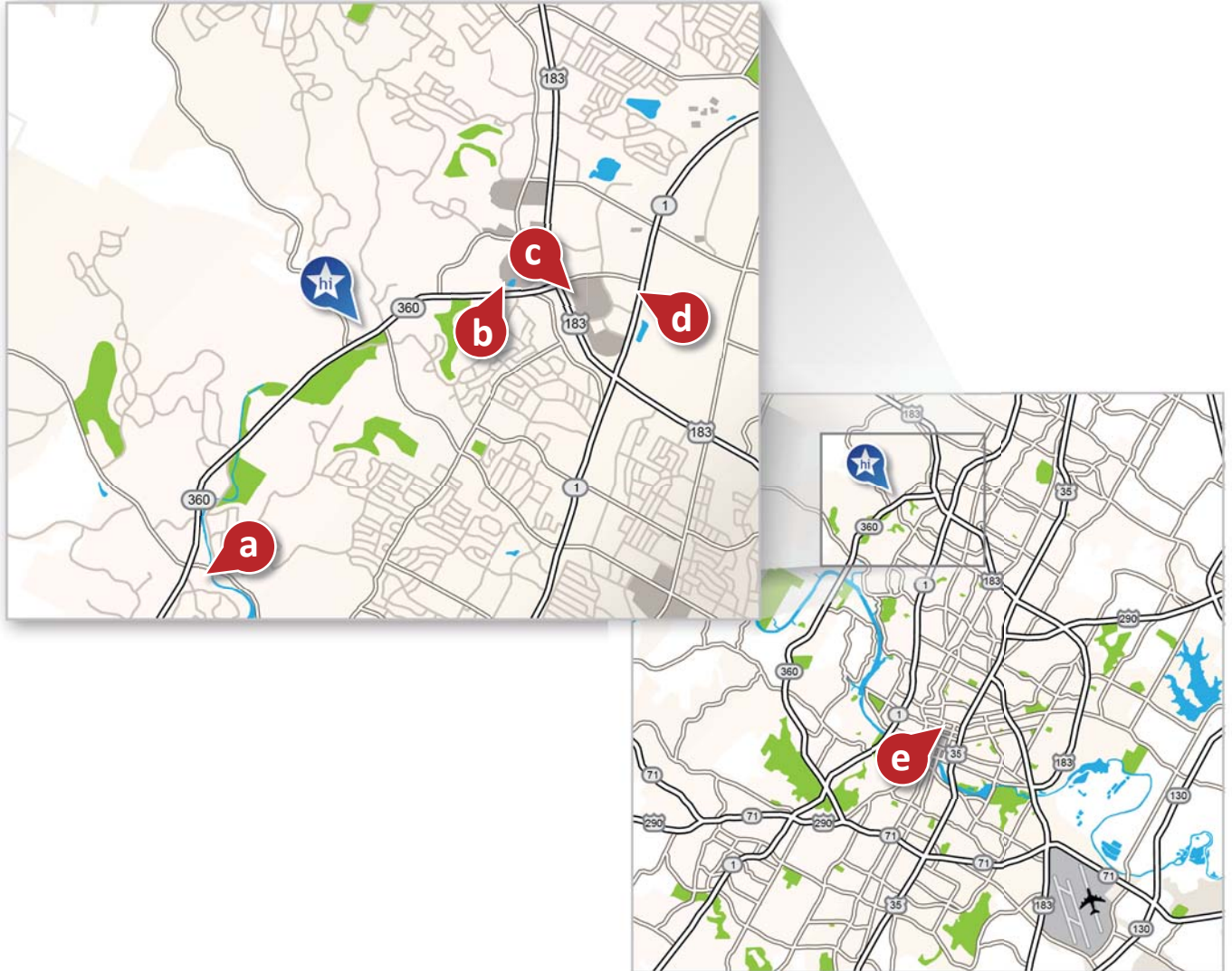
Get a good night's sleep and wake up refreshed ready to take on the day in any one of these great places to stay.

Restaurants

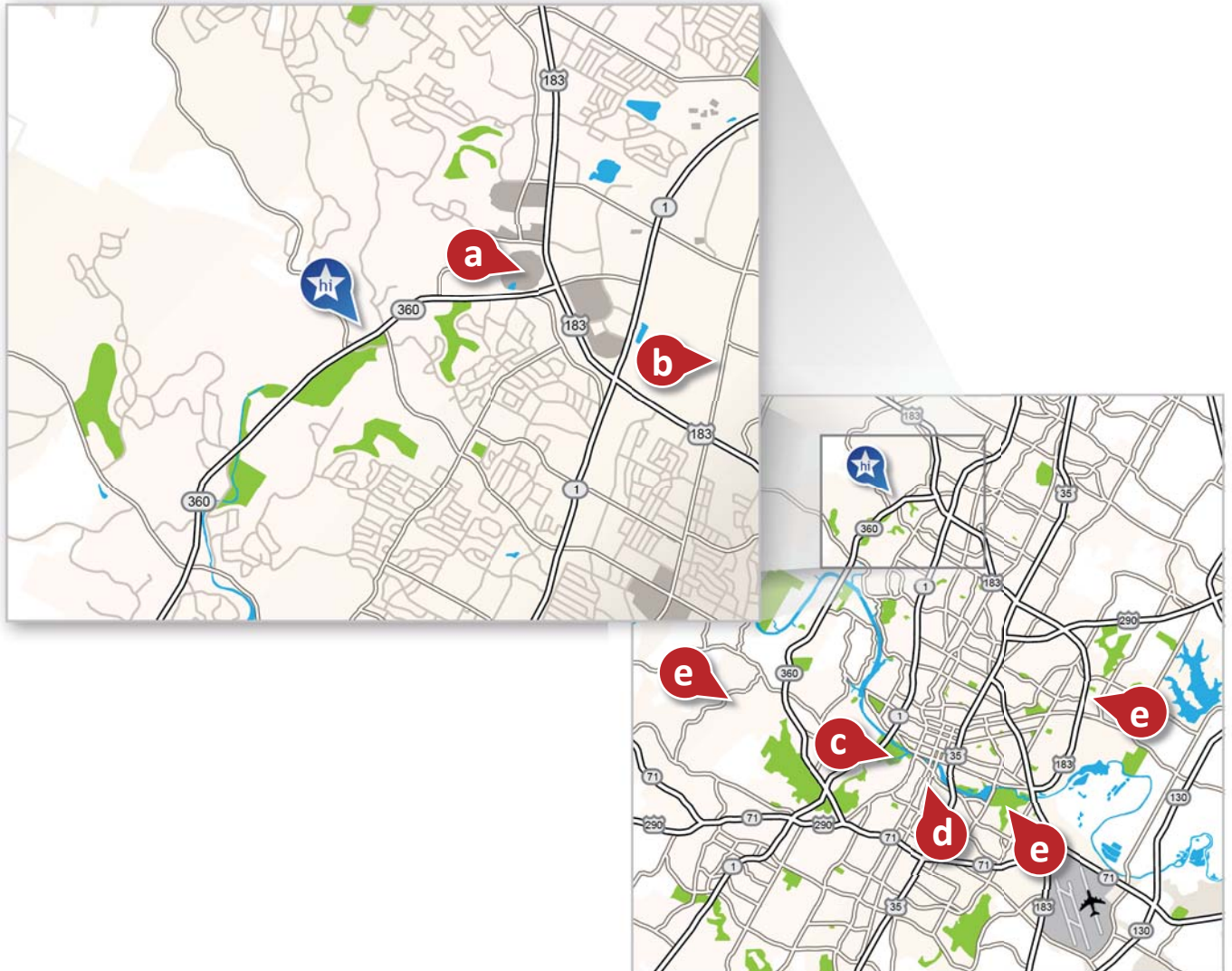
Everyone has to eat, right? Wine and dine yourself in style. Austin has it all. From trailer goodies to 5-star steakhouses.

Activities

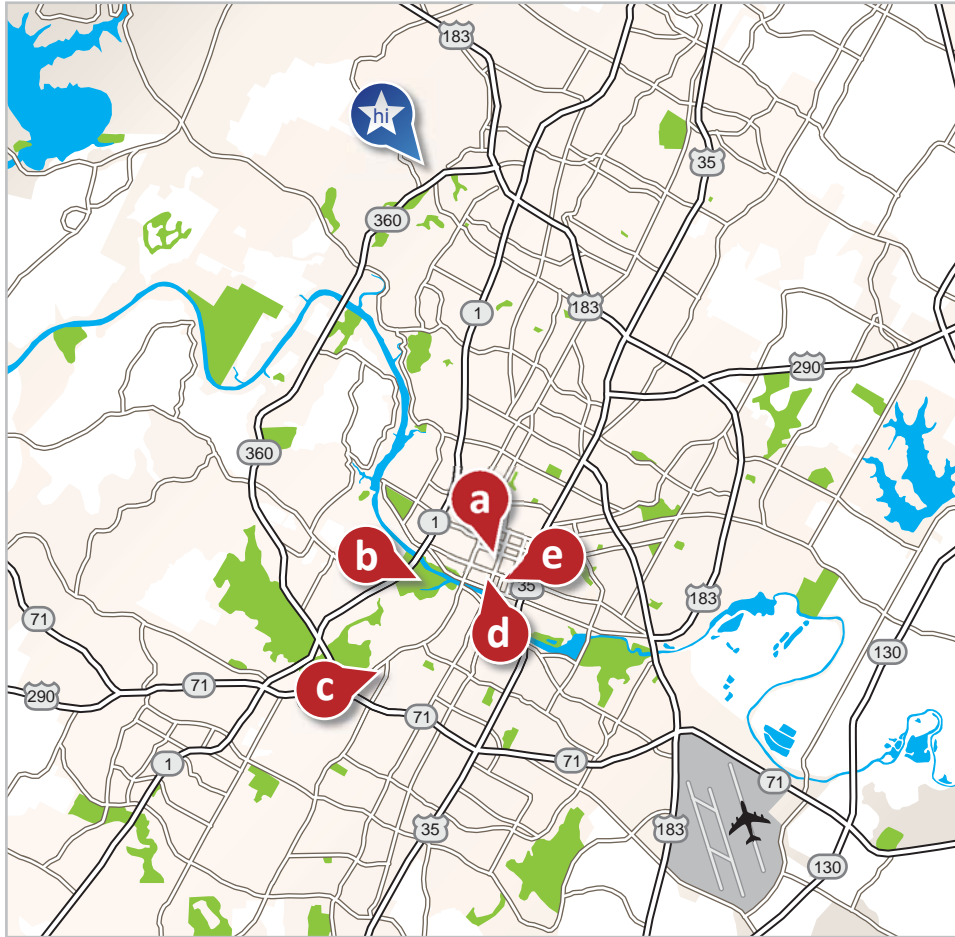
Looking for that perfect momento or a gift to bring back home? Perhaps you might be more into losing a ball or two around the local links?

d 6th Street

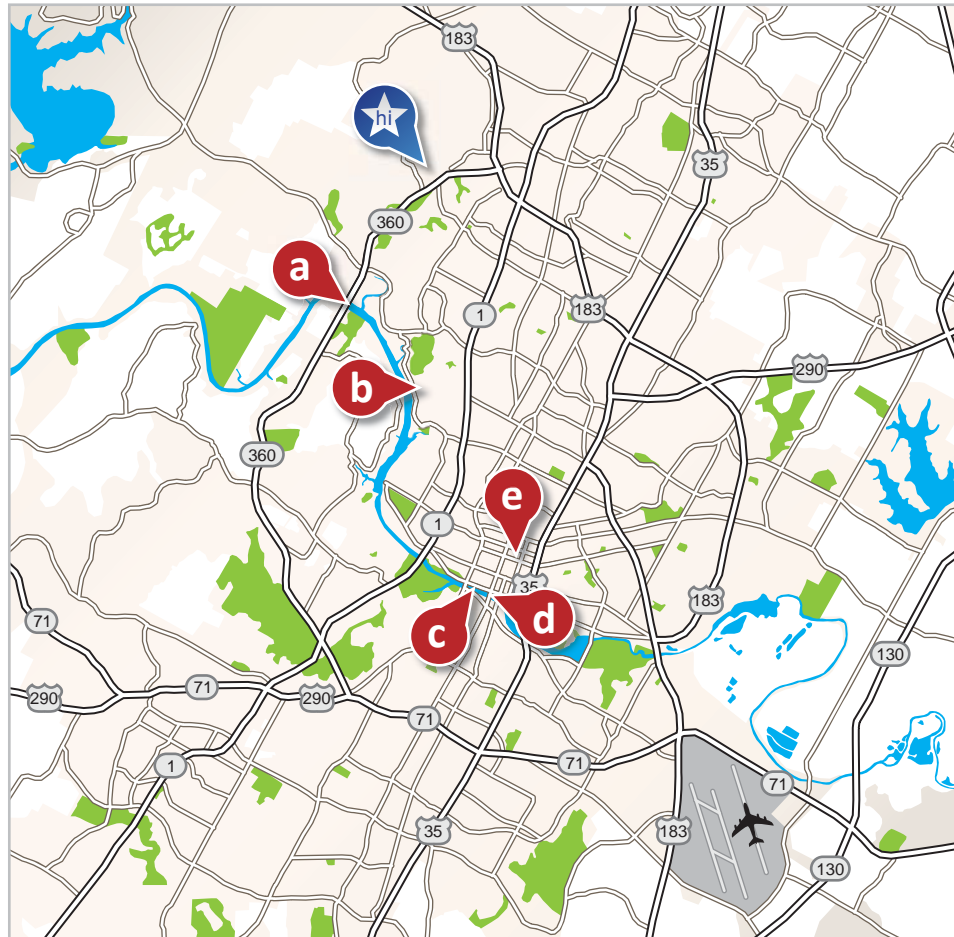
One of Austin most famous destination has every kind of hot spot that you could ever dream of.
